- Provide access to high-quality cancer screening, follow-up tests, getting treatment and support services to individuals who are uninsured.
- Assist the uninsured population with referrals to NYS of Health Insurance Marketplace and Navigators.
- Focus on populations disproportionally burdened by increased cancer risk and/or who are medically unserved or underserved
- To provide life-saving breast, cervical and colorectal cancer screenings and/or diagnostic and treatment services to individuals without health insurance. And to provide community health education regarding the importance of cancer prevention and early detection.

- Younger high risk men & women

#### **Services Provided:**

- Mammograms & clinical breast exams
- Pap & Pelvic Exams
- Follow-up testing
- Colorectal Cancer tests
- Treatment for breast, cervical, and colorectal cancers

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The Cancer Services Program By the Numbers...

In 2018-2021, your local Cancer Services Program;

- Provided 650 screening procedures to 555 people
- Diagnosed: 9 breast cancer cases and 14 precancerous/cancerous colorectal cases.
- Facilitated follow ups with **178** breast screening patients, **10** cervical screening patients, and **80** colorectal screening patients.
- Worked with primary care offices to contact patients overdue for cancer screenings and assist them to obtain screenings
